Chemical Properties

Wood can burn. Does it have the same physical properties after it burns? NO!

- It is no longer wood, it is <u>soot</u> or <u>ash</u>.
- ▶ Wood is <u>combustible</u> (it can burn) and this is a chemical property.

<u>Chemical Property</u> – is a description of what a substances does when it reacts to <u>produce new</u> substances. It has new physical properties.

An object can be...

- #1. Combustible
- #2. Reactive.
