

Evaluating our Energy Use

- ▶ Guelph Hydro monitors how much electrical energy we use
- ▶ We are billed by how much we use
- ▶ Of course, the less we use, the lower our bill!
- ▶ Use energy wisely by:
 - #1 - unplug chargers when done.
 - #2 - Use 'sleep' or 'energy saver' modes
 - #3 - Turn lights off!
 - #4 - Do full loads of laundry
 - #5 - Use CFL lightbulbs
 - #6 - Try a slightly warmer house in summer

AND



a slightly cooler house in winter.



The amount of energy we use is measured in kilowatt hours (kW·h).

The more kilowatt hours we use, the higher our electricity bill!

A kilowatt hour costs between 6 cents and 12 cents to use. There are times of day in which energy is cheaper.

Cheaper energy times:

- Early morning
- After supper
- All weekend

Try to use electricity at these times if possible!
