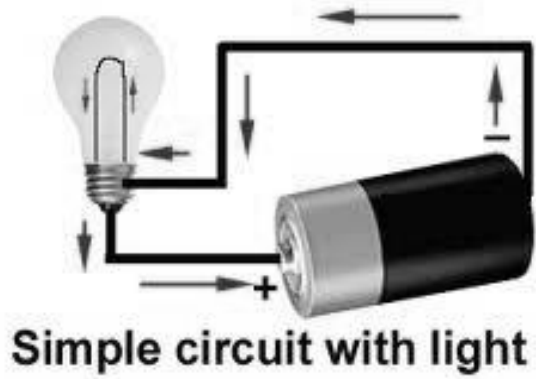


## Forms of Current Electricity (AC vs. DC)

### DC (Direct Current)

- ⦿ In a direct current circuit, the electrons only flow 1 way. A battery provides direct current.



### AC ( Alternating Current)

- ⦿ Alternating current means the electrons move back and forth. We say the 'oscillate'.
- ⦿ This is the kind of electrical energy provided by your electrical plugs. (from generators)
